Since joining Saint Mark's Parish in 2002, Bob has given generously of his time and talent, despite the substantial demands of his successful career as a key executive at Microsoft. He served ably on the Vestry from 2007 to 2010 and as a Junior Warden for the past two years. Bob demonstrated courage, wisdom, and compassion during the Vestry's difficult deliberations and decisions concerning the former Dean.
