MLK50: Where Do We Go From Here? WEDNESDAY, APRIL 4,
4:07 p.m. Ringing of Bells, Cathedral Nave; 6:45 p.m. Cathedral Commons, Bloedel Hall
On April 4, we remember the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. 50 years ago, and the legacy he left. All are invited to join in the Nave at 4:07 p.m. to ring our bell 39 times, once for each year of Dr. King's life. The Cathedral Commons conversation at 6:45 p.m. will consider the theme: 'MLK50: Where do we go from here?' This is the title of his last book and a speech delivered August 16, 1967. We'll also share plans that are forming to commemorate the passing of a local civil rights leader, Edwin Pratt.
